KAIRO'S #27 SEPT 29-30 Oct 1-2

The Kairo's Prison Ministry takes a group of 24 inmates for 4 hours on Thursday,12hours on Friday and Saturday and 8 hours on Sunday to teach them Christian principals and how to have a Christian community within a prison. Andres Galego, Danny Walker and I are the FBC members on this 22 person team. Things you can do to help the ministry.

Starting Sunday September 25, bring packages of sliced cheese (need at least 100 slices), at least 5 dozen hard boiled eggs (unpeeled), boxes of snack cakes and packages of non chocolate covered cookies. We need 75 packages each. We will pass out sacks of 18 cookies to each of the 2000 inmate plus sacks of 12 to the officers and staff. That comes to about 45,000 cookies we need for the 3 1/2 days.

DIXIE JACKSON

With much encouragement from Dixie Jackson, the first Week of Prayer for Arkansas state missions was held in 1926. Before Jackson died in early 1929, an offering was added to the Week of Prayer, with more than \$1000 being collected to aiinspiring and encouraging to see how much every aspect of the Dixie Jackson State Missions Offering has grown in spreading the Gospel and ministering to Arkansans since 1929. Here are a few examples from the last year:

Baptist Collegiate Ministry: 7,390 students contacted through the BCM, plus 719 Gospel presentations - all during the first month of college.

Disaster Relief: 1,349 Total volunteers deployed, making 1,372 contacts d mission projects statewide in that first year. In 1935, the annual offering was named the Dixie Jackson Offering for State Missions in her memory. It is so and resulting in 43 professions of faith.

Pregnancy Care Centers: 3,497 Gospel presentations resulting in 185 professions of faith. Also 467 babies were saved from abortion.
