**AIDE FOR UKRAINE  
OCTOBER 2, 2022**

Sunday October 2nd I will be leaving for Ukraine with a small team. My plan is to fly into Poland and then travel to Lviv, Ukraine. I will be carrying as much medications and medical supplies as I can to the Ukrainian hospitals and volunteer where I can. Last April we brought a ton of supplies to Ukraine and in October we are planning on bringing 2 tons of medications and medical supplies. Lviv has been called the city of refuge in Ukraine. Many wounded and displaced people have come to this city. I feel that the Ukrainian people are important to God, therefore the Ukrainian people are important to us. If you are interested in helping us with this endeavor, purchase lifesaving medications and medical supplies for hospitals in Ukraine, and help with the freight cost, funds can be sent in a couple different ways.

My answer is yes, during World War 2 with the Nazi invasion of The Netherlands, I had family members that only survived the war due to the generosity of strangers, if they did not receive this help, they would not have survived the war. Now it is our turn to help those in need. There is a little risk in making this trip, so I would appreciate your prayers.

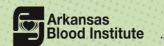
